


Cocaine Chart– BA036

<p>Image</p>	 <p>Harmful effects of Cocaine</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Brain <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Stroke and death Addiction and withdrawal Seizures, bizarre and violent behavior Severe depression Eyes <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Blurred vision Nose <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Snorting cocaine causes nose damage and deformity Throat <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Sore, hoarse, and difficulty swallowing Lungs <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Shortness of breath due to alveolar damage (round air sacs) Respiratory failure Severe chest pain Constant cough Liver <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Damage from contracting Hepatitis C or HIV (from contaminated needles) Heart <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Heart attack and death Increases blood pressure, heart rate, and risk of irregular heart beat Stomach <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Loss of appetite Malnutrition and weight loss Intestines <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Nausea, pain, and diarrhea Possible bowel gangrene Skin <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Sores and infections from injections Blood vessels <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Constricts blood vessels increasing blood pressure, risk of heart attack, stroke, and death Reproductive system <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Infertility Miscarriages Birth defects Still births Impotence in men
