

Sectional Anatomy and Function of Circulatory System Chart-CT079

Description	This is a full colour laminated chart and illustrates how blood flows throughout the body to and
	from the heart. It shows the main arteries and veins of the head and neck as well as those
	supplying the shoulder and thigh and explains how the blood flows to and from these areas of
	the body. The Hepatic Portal System is also illustrated showing the hepatic portal vein and
	explaining how the system collects blood from the whole of the bowl in the abdomen. The
	hepatic portal system consists of the Liver, Stomach, Spleen, Small Intestine, Ascending and
	Descending Colon and Rectum.
	 This is an extremely useful chart for any student studying the circulatory system as well as
	hospital teaching departments for nurses doing incentre training. It is colourful and easy to
	understand. Two views of the heart illustrate and name the arteries and veins that supply
	blood to and from the heart. It is one of three charts in the Cardio-respiratory system set and
	therefore it is essential to purchase the set.
